



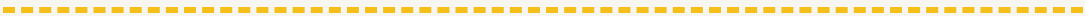

No better time for the project's first newsletter than its anniversary!

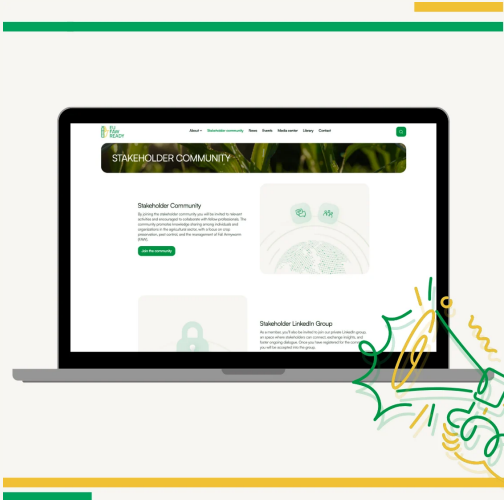
Thank you, everyone, for your dedication and hard work during these 12 months, and to all the rest who have been following us closely.

If you are interested in participating in relevant activities and wish to be in contact with like-minded professionals and experts, we invite you to join the project's Stakeholder Community.



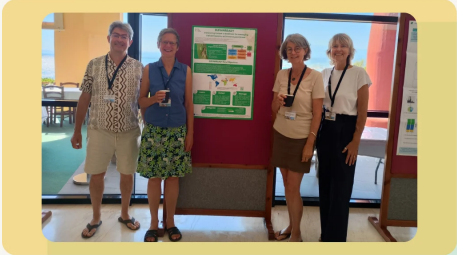

The partners engaged in numerous interactive sessions after updating each other on the project progress.

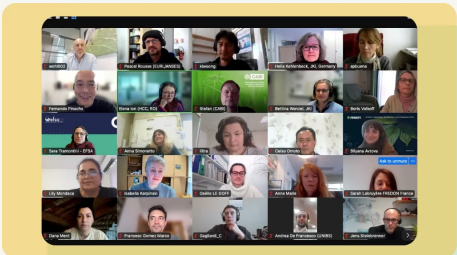

Participated in a clustering event on Sustainable Pest and Chemical Risk Management in Europe

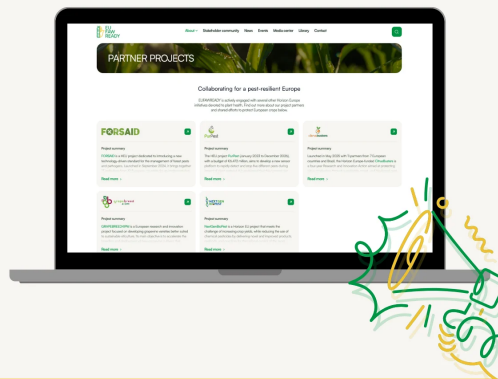

Launched two social media campaigns

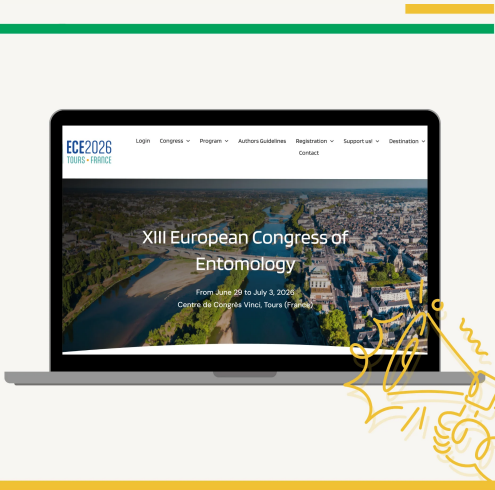
